### Ridgeway Academy Student wins Shell's National Schools' Competition

A Ridgeway Academy student has been recognised as the winner in Shell's National Schools' competition – The Bright Ideas Challenge.

Scarlett Beskeen in Year 9 won the competition with an amazing entry using Minecraft to design her future city.

Students were tasked with using their science, technology, engineering and maths (STEM) skills to come up with creative solutions to the energy challenges that cities will face in 2050.

Scarlett worked on this in her Geography lessons in lockdown and came up with some fantastic ideas for future designs.

The school received £10,000 from Shell that will go towards STEM projects at Ridgeway Academy. Scarlett also won an exciting prize pack which includes:

- 12-month subscription to KiwiCo's 'Tinker Crate' kit – a monthly package that comes complete with fun, hands-on STEM kit designed to spark students' creativity and curiosity.
- Tech Will Save us 'Spark pack' that will get students building and coding their own handheld games console and music synth.
- 3-month subscription to the Future Inventors Club, taking their coding to the next level!

Last year Ridgeway Academy came 77th out of registered schools worldwide. Congratulations to everyone who took part!!







## Library News


