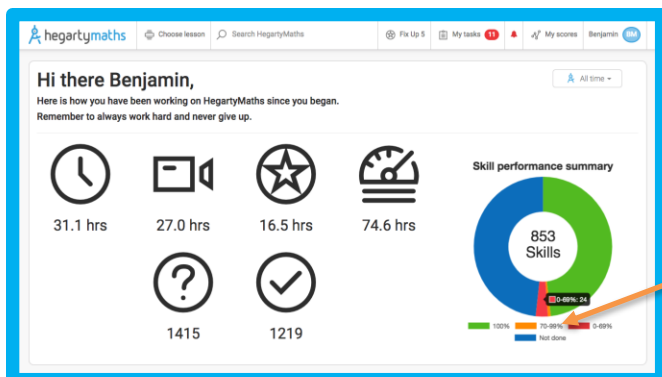


## 10 things a student should do when completing hegarty**maths** homework

	Student checklist for good hegarty <b>maths</b> homework	✓ or ✗
1	I always write the date, title, clip number and H/W for all my tasks.	
2	I always watch the video before attempting the questions.	
3	I always take full notes of all the examples modelled in the video.	
4	I copy every question that I attempt in my book.	
5	I show all my workings for every question in the quiz that I do.	
6	I try to model my work the way I was shown in the video by Mr Hegarty.	
7	I use a pencil and ruler for all diagrams.	
8	I mark my work correct/incorrect as I go.	
9	I write down corrections when hegarty <b>maths</b> tells me the correct answer.	
10	I write down my score at the end of quiz.
