School Communications Policy

Emails

Please use the following email addresses when communicating with Departments:

For all communication around Attendance: attendance@ridgeway.aat.school

For all communication around Detentions: detentions@ridgeway.aat.school

If you need to contact staff for any other matters: admin@ridgeway.aat.school

If you need to make reference to your child in the subject header of your email, please use initials.

In the main body paragraph of your email, please include a bold FAO [for the attention of] heading to help our admin team direct your enquiry to the correct teacher or leader.

E.g. FAO Mr Smith regarding Science Trip and RTO, Year 9A

Do note that: Teachers are not in a position to check emails consistently throughout the day and the school does not expect work email to be checked during a teacher's personal time.

We aim to respond to you as soon as possible within three working days. Part-time staff may take longer to reply.

Teachers, on occasion, may find it easier to email you regarding your child using the contact details we have on file. It is acceptable to continue these conversations directly with the member of staff once they have contacted you, but any subsequent new question or issue should be raised through the admin@ridgeway.aat.school

Attendance Procedures

Registration

A reminder that if students do not report to morning or afternoon registration they will be marked as unauthorised. Morning registration starts at 8:25.

Medical Appointments

If your child has an urgent appointment that cannot be taken out of school hours, they will still be required to be in school both before and after the appointment where possible. If they are not in before/ after the appointment this will be classed as unauthorised. You must provide an appointment card/letter for any absence to be classed as medical, otherwise your child will be marked in as late or as an unauthorised absence.

What is Medical Evidence? Once you are on the fixed penalty notice warning system you will need to provide medical evidence for us to be able to authorise time off. Medical evidence can be:

- Prescription
- Hospital letter
- Signed note from the GP or nurse
- Medicine with the prescribed sticker on it
- Appointment card with name and date on it

If you are unsure please ask to speak to a member of the attendance team for more information.

Changes to Mobile Device Policy

I can confirm that from September 2023 our Mobile device policy has changed to include the following points:

- Students are strongly advised not to bring any mobile devices into school, the school cannot take responsibility for any lost or stolen devices.
- Where a student needs to bring a device to school, this will be locked in a form time locker (locked by their tutor) during morning registration and returned at the end of the day during afternoon registration.
- Students with medical exceptions will continue to be able to keep their phones with them during the day. Medical evidence will be required.
- In the case of lateness to school or a planned appointment, students will hand their phones to student services, they will be locked in a locker until the student signs out.

We have taken the decision to change our mobile device policy to safeguard all our students from incidents of misuse of social media and sharing of images during school time.
